



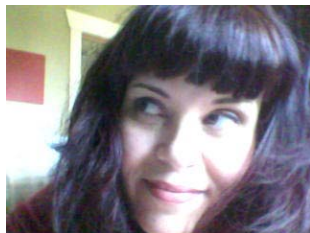
## Theater Instructors
