



**Ap(art) [say, “art apart”]** is a 24 hour art event taking place at ART 634 on Friday, October 15<sup>rd</sup> through October 16<sup>th</sup>.

During the event, artists will begin and complete at least one work of art in a 24 hour period of time before a live audience wandering throughout ART 634.

Artists may select to designate all of the proceeds or a percentage (40% or more) to support the Jackson School of the Arts programs that make the arts accessible to disadvantaged children in our community.

All works of art will be auctioned on site and on the web. The Ap(art) event and bidding ends with a closing reception for all artists and the public on Saturday, 4-5 PM.

## **FAQ's**

### **What exactly will proceeds from the sale of my art work be used for?**

The Jackson School of the Arts is a nonprofit organization with a 9 year history of providing quality arts programs for children and employment to artists. \$20 subsidizes the cost for a child from a low-income family to participate in a month of art, dance or theater classes. So if your work sells for \$200 and you donate 1/2—a child gets to benefit from the arts for 5 months!!!

**When should I sign up?** Today! The event is coming soon, and we want to get a lot of advance press for participating artists.

### **How much of a time commitment is this?**

You decide. Let us know how much time you need. The event is 5 PM-11 PM Friday, Oct. 15 & 10 AM-5 PM on Saturday, Oct. 16.

We would like all artists to attend the closing reception on Saturday 4-5 PM, and we will ask for your help in promoting the event with your friends on Facebook or by providing your email list of friends, family and other contacts who would like to know about your art.
